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Jigawa Governor Praises FUTB Management's Compassion on Split Payment of Registration Fees

The Executive Governor of Jigawa State, Malam Umar A. Namadi FCA has praised the leadership of the Federal University of Technology Babura, leadership for their care and compassion, in staggering the payment of registration fees by students. He gave the commendation on Wednesday 19th June, 2024, at Government House Dutse, when the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sabo Ibrahim Birnin Kudu led the Principal Officers (POs) on a courtesy visit.

The Governor who congratulated the University for its achievements to date including academic activities and completion of the buildings of two of its Schools, also promised to assist state indigenes "not on a permanent basis but upon availability of funds or as and when due". Malam Umar not only promised to assist the university further on accommodation but will also study other requests presented by the university so as to assist it appropriately.

Earlier the Vice Chancellor had congratulated the Jigawa State Governor for the laudable achievements recorded in the first year of his administration, while also condoling him on his recent loss of an in-law. Prof. Birnin Kudu also expressed great appreciation to the Governor and government of Jigawa for the supportive and numerous assistance given towards the take-off of the university, including 4 vehicles for the POs, use of JICORAS campus, donation of a large

expanse of land for the permanent site along Kano Road as well as accommodation for the VC and Registrar.

The Vice Chancellor also briefed the Governor on the progress of academic activities by eight departments running 13 programmes with the university recently matriculating its second set of students. Of the total student population, both genders, of 1,015, Jigawa has 273, while

out of a total female population of 77, Jigawa has 42; but most of the Jigawa students are indigent. According to him despite staggering the payment of registration fees many students still find it difficult to pay, so he appealed to the State Government to take over payment for the indigent students from Jigawa.

He happily reported the completion of the buildings of the Schools of Engineering and Technology, as well as the School of Science, Information and Communication Technology; while structures for the School of Information and Communication Technology, University Library and Centre for Information Technology (CIT) are nearing completion too.

The Vice Chancellor appealed to Jigawa State to assist the university in any way possible to tackle the challenges of lack of access roads on the Permanent Campus, inadequate accommodation and lack of a shuttle buses for commuting to and between the two campuses. While praising the Governor for the Tertiary Institutions Host Community Housing Project going on opposite the Permanent Campus, he appealed for construction of some inside the campus with a structured form of payment.

"By the resolution of the Congregation", said the letter, "you are expected to be presenting periodic reports on the activities of the UMC to the Congregation through the Secretariat."

GENERAL CIRCULAR ON PUBLIC HEALTH

To: All Staff & Students

CHOLERA AWARENESS

Following a reported cases of the outbreak of Cholera disease in some part of the country, members of the University community are hereby alerted to be cautious, as directed by public health officials.

Cholera, is a contagious disease and therefore, staff and students are advised to take precautionary measures with a view to protecting themselves from contracting it, as well as containing its spread.

What to know about Cholera

- Highly Contagious: Causes diarrhea and vomiting.
- 2. **Source:** Spread through food or water contaminated with *Vibrio cholerae* bacteria.
- 3. **Effects:** The bacteria produce a toxin in the small intestine, leading to severe dehydration and potentially death if untreated.

Sources of Cholera Infection

- 1. Contaminated water
- 2. Raw seafood
- 3. Raw fruits and vegetables
- 4. Contact with the feces of an infected person

Tips on Prevention

- 1. Wash fruits and vegetables thoroughly.
- Avoid poorly cooked food or food from untrusted sources. Eat wellcooked food.
- Drink boiled or bottled water.
- 4. Wash hands regularly with soap and water, especially after using the toilet.
- 5. Maintain proper sanitation and dispose of waste properly.

Important Note

Most people infected with *Vibrio cholerae* do not show symptoms but can still spread the bacteria through their feces for 1-10 days.

Members of the University community suspecting any of the above symptoms should report to the Clinic or the nearest Hospital immediately, for investigation and treatment.
